Affirmed Housing Group is proud to partner with PATH Ventures and Family Health Centers of San Diego in developing Connections Housing. Located in downtown San Diego, Connections is a one-stop service center, transitional and permanent housing development designed to transition the homeless population into housing. The mission of this development is to provide a single location where nonprofit medical and social service providers collaborate to serve the homeless of San Diego with comprehensive, holistic services.

An estimated 8,000 people are homeless on any given night in San Diego. Widespread foreclosures, the demands of returning veterans, and the reduction of federal funding for affordable housing create constant challenges in a declining economy. Dealing with the vexing problem requires intervention not only by government but also the community at large.

Connections Housing will provide life-skills training, resume writing, computer training and other skill-building courses designed to transition residents back into the workforce. Residents will also have access to onsite medical offices, a dental office, hair salon and legal office. Connections Housing will provide 150 transitional units and 75 permanent apartments, providing housing for a total of 225 homeless San Diegan's. To learn more please visit www.sdconnections.org

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## Affirmed Housing Celebrates Grand Re-Opening of Sage Pointe Apartments

In 2008, Affirmed Housing Group partnered with the City of San Marcos to rehabilitate an ailing market rate property, Autumn Park. Now known as Sage Pointe, the renovated, 40-unit community consists of (31) 2 bedroom/1 bath units and (9) 1 bedroom/1 bath units and offers muchneeded housing for low-income individuals and families. Interior improvements included new bathrooms and kitchens complete with new Energy Star appliances, countertops, and cabinets; new electrical and plumbing systems; new heating and air conditioning; new paint; new flooring; and new washers and dryers for the complex. Exterior enhancements included all brand new roofing, extensive balcony repairs, paint, fencing, re-paving, improved landscaping with a new water conservation system, mailboxes, barbeques, benches, and a tot lot.

Sage Pointe's financing partners included Torrey Pines Bank and the City of San Marcos Redevelopment Association. The development team included developer Affirmed Housing Group, Studio E Architects, general contractor Critical Pointe Construction, civil engineer Masson & Associates, and landscape architect Darsono Design.

## Lotus Garden breaks ground

Affirmed Housing broke ground on Lotus Garden Apartments on Monday, April 4, 2011. Designed by Los Angeles-based Togawa Smith Martin Residential, Inc., the project is designed to achieve LEED certification. As Affirmed Housing Group's first development in Los Angeles, the 100% affordable project incorporates green elements and innovative technology to make it a truly distinctive project.

As an all-affordable development, Lotus Garden will serve families earning between 30%-60% of Los Angeles County's median income. With rents ranging from \$370 (studio) to \$1,236 (3 bedroom), the project will provide quality housing to 60 families.

Lotus Garden will also be the first project in Southern California to use Harding Steel's CARMATRIX© semi-automated parking system. This innovative system allows users to park their cars on platforms, which can move vertically for a stacking effect,

and horizontally, to allow the needed car to be accessed at grade level. The four-level podium parking structure will maximize the number of cars that can be parked in a compact space, as demonstrated at www.hardingsteel.com

## Poway City Council approves Orange Gardens with a 5-0 vote

Passing with a unanimous vote, Poway's Orange Garden will now be rehabilitated by Affirmed Housing Group. The recent acquisition is a 52 apartment unit complex featuring 1,2,and 3 bedroom apartments that will now be available to persons earning 30-60% of the areas median income. Located at 12510 Oak Knoll Road in Poway, the extensive rehab of the 20 year old complex will include new heating, air conditioning, washers, dryers, plumbing, repairs to the floors and walls, and a fresh painting of the entire complex using low VOC paints. Features will also include new fencing around the property, new landscaping and all new pavement in the parking lot. Tenants will also enjoy a new tot lot, barbecue and picnic area as well as a new community building.
