This innovative community features numerous green aspects including a 119.8 kW photovoltaic solar system, solar water heating system, low flow fixtures, recycling chutes, car chargers for electric vehicles and dedicated parking for efficient vehicles, to name a few. A 63 unit housing development is ok'd on Imperial Ave., in downtown San Diego. The permanent supportive housing development will consist of studio apartments serving very lowand extremely-low income residents. Equipped with a photovoltaic and solar hot water system, the energy efficient community will feature interior and exterior community gathering areas including a WiFi lounge, a fitness room, and a common area kitchen and community garden.

City of Vista tour at Paseo Pointe

Paseo Pointe was recently toured by the City Vista Mayor Judv Ritter. Councilmembers Amanda Rigby and David Cowles, the City Manager Patrick Johnson Director John Meyer, the Redevelopment and Housing. It is beautifully designed new landmark in the Paseo Santa Fe redevelopment area of the City of Vista. The 69 unit family community includes studios, one, two, and three bedroom residences. Opened to the public March 2013, Connections Housing offers permanent housing, interim housing, a career center offering numerous courses, a health center and full kitchen. The first of its kind in San Diego, the community has proven itself worthy of emulation, and has succeeded in numerous ways- we are so proud to be involved!

- 551 people moved into permanent housing
- 940 placements into PATH/Alpha Project's interim housing program by PATH's street outreach team
- 23,000+ visits to the on-site health center, Family Health Centers of San Diego
- 279 people secured full-time employment through their efforts in the Depot Career Center at Connections.
- 70% reduction in homelessness in surrounding neighborhood
