3 new, permanent supportive housing developments



## Aria

Located in downtown Los Angeles, Aria will offer 57 apartment homes for the homeless. The supportive housing development will be built by Walton Construction and has been designed by Togawa Smith Martin. The development is funded by the City of LA, Banner Bank, Boston Capital, etc.

#### Della Rosa

Located in Westminster, the new community will offer 50 apartments for the homeless and low income families. The Development team includes HA Builders, Dahlin Group, Fuscoe



Engineers, and MJS. The project is financed by CCRC, US Bank, County of Orange, City of Westminster, and HUD.



## The Link

Located at 707 17th Street in downtown San Diego, The Link will offer 88 supportive housing units for the homeless. The sleek new development has been designed by Carrier Johnson + Culture and will be built by general contractor, HA Builders. Funding for this new development includes Bank of

America, Civic San Diego, and the San Diego Housing Commission.
